

KAUFMAN ISD - MAINTENANCE REPORT NOVEMBER 2025


The Kaufman ISD maintenance team has continued to work on improvement projects around the district. In addition, there were over 225 work orders completed during the month of October.

Here are a few of the projects that the team has been working on this month:





The concrete gym floor at Phillips Elementary has been topped with a new competition surface. The new floor looks great and is highly functional.







Ground work on the new junior high property has officially begun. Thousands of cubic yards of material has been moved thus far. Even the KISD maintenance crew chipped in to relocate some valuable clay.

KISD electricians have been working across the district to replace light fixtures that have burned out. Here they are working on the tennis courts.





Whenever possible, the crew converts old light units with new LED technology. This provides better light with far better energy consumption.






Below the crew removes a dead tree from the front lawn at the Administration Building.

There are 16 vehicles (including 2 bucket trucks) that the maintenance department uses to provide service around the district. The maintenance and transportation departments combine to maintain these vehicles. 13 of these units are in good working order. 3 of the older units (25 yrs +) are in poor condition and we will likely recommend them for auction before the next school year begins.
