The Summer Breakfast Program has a count of 1100, the Lunch Program is at 3684 and the Supper Program is at 1180 for a total of 5,964.

Our schedule for Summer Breakfast is from 8am to 11am at both Browning Elementary and Browning Middle Schools.

The Summer Lunch Schedule is 11am to 3:30pm at both Browning Elementary and Browning Middle Schools.

The Summer Supper Program is at the Napi Elementary School from 4:30pm to 7:30pm.

We will be closed on the 4th of July. We will be serving Lunch July 10, 2019 at the Government Square during the Blackfeet Children's Day activities. We also will be serving Lunch at the Campgrounds, July 11th and July 12th during the Northern Native American Indian Days Celebration.

We have the two units that travel in and around our area to help serve the youth that cannot make it to the schools in Starr School and Femaville areas. We have added the Death Row area by the 'Twin Towers' and also the Browning Public Library, these two additions will help to reach more Youth.

The Lunch Box a.k.a The Food Mobile is at Death Row from 11-11:30am, the Blackfeet Homes from 11:40am to 12:10pm and then the Skate Park from 12:20-3pm.

The Park 'N' Eat Bus is at Old Low Rent at 11 to 11:30am, Low Rent from 11:40am-12:10pm, Sinclair Drive (Femaville) at 12:20-12:50pm, then to Starr School at 1-1:45pm and finally to the Browning Public Library at 2 to 2:30pm.
