

**RESOLUTION OF THE PASADENA INDEPENDENT  
SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES DECLARING  
SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY**

The Board of Trustees of Pasadena Independent School District (the “District”) hereby makes the following findings in connection with a certain tract of land described as approximately 7.179 acres located at the southeast corner of 206 N. Perez St. in South Houston, Harris County, Texas, and generally depicted in the attached Exhibit A (the “Property”):

1. WHEREAS, the Pasadena Independent School District Board of Trustees has the authority to declare real property no longer needed for school purposes as surplus property;
2. WHEREAS, the District no longer needs the Property for school purposes;
3. WHEREAS, the District desires to advertise the Property for sale in accordance with applicable laws, including Section 272.001 of the Texas Local Government Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, (1) that the Board of Trustees of the Pasadena Independent School District hereby declares the Property to be surplus property; and (ii) that the Board of Trustees of the Pasadena Independent School District hereby authorizes its Superintendent or designee to publicly advertise the Property for sale and solicit sealed offers for purchase of the Property, as required by Texas law.
