 Provide a detailed rationale explaining how the waiver will enhance student learning opportunities, promote innovation or increase equitable access to effective teachers. Include information about the problem or obstacle, if any, the waiver will help the district overcome.

The Hackett School District is seeking an ACT 1240 waiver in order to participate in the Teacher Apprenticeship Program administered through the University of Arkansas at Fort Smith (UAFS). By partnering with UAFS and participating in the Teacher Apprenticeship Program, the Hackett School District hopes to increase our capacity to recruit and retain highly effective elementary teachers while addressing the current teacher shortage issues.

With the approval of this waiver request, the Hackett School District and more specifically Hackett Elementary School, will partner with UAFS to place two apprentices in 5th grade. One intern will fill a vacant teaching position, due to a retiring teacher while the second intern will assume the teaching responsibilities of the mentor teacher's classroom. The highly qualified mentor teacher will work directly with both apprentices providing support and feedback through coaching, modeling and observation. Both apprentices will be compensated with a .5 first year teaching contract for the duration of a standard school year (2 semesters).

In order to provide a more focused, hands-on experience, the apprentices and the mentor teacher will be provided multiple layers of support from school, district and university leadership. Apprentices will participate in administrator led weekly grade level team meetings with other 5th grade teachers. Additional time will be scheduled for the apprentice and mentor teacher to discuss content, instructional strategies, student data, unit planning and other related topics. The mentor teacher will be provided university support to provide strategies for coaching and reflective practice. In addition to the assigned university supervisor, apprentices and the mentor teacher will receive consistent support from the Executive Director of the School of Education and of the UAFS Educational Renewal Zone (ERZ) Director. The building principal along with the Executive Director and the ERZ Director will make regular visits to the apprentices classrooms and will hold support meetings as needed.

The UAFS Teacher Apprenticeship Program is a model of internship which strengthens and grows not only the apprentice's instructional practice, but also the district's qualified teacher pool, the mentor teacher's leadership capacity and the partnership between school districts and higher education. The Hackett School District looks forward to the opportunity of implementing the apprenticeship model at Hackett Elementary now and in the future.

2. Provide a detailed explanation of how the services being waived will be provided for students.

Students assigned to these apprenticeship model classrooms will have the benefit of having an additional teacher in their classroom for at least half of the school day. The mentor teacher along with the apprentices will be focused on strong instructional practices and measuring student achievement. A highly collaborative team will be created as the mentor and apprentices plan, practice and reflect together. Additionally, the mentor teacher will be available to create a more personalized learning experience for students by having the time to provide individual and small group instruction for students.

3. Provide a detailed explanation of how the district will monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the waiver.

The Hackett School District and Hackett Elementary will monitor the effectiveness of the Teacher Apprenticeship Program through multiple sources of data including:

- *Regular and timely feedback from the mentor teacher, apprentices, UAFS Executive Director and ERZ Director
- *Classroom student achievement data including formative assessment data, observational data, and reading levels
- *Survey data from teachers, students, parents
- *Staffing data
