**SUBJECT (item as it will appear on agenda):** Radiology Student Fee for HESI Testing & Trajecsys Tracker

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve Radiology student fees, effective fall 2016

**BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:** It is typical for an allied health program to regularly assess student progress throughout the curriculum. For those allied health programs whose accrediting bodies require graduates pass a licensing or accrediting exam, faculty may provide various forms of practice testing. HESI testing provides multiple opportunities for faculty to assess student knowledge, provide content-specific remediation as needed, and allow student practice testing prior to taking the Radiology accrediting/licensing exam.


For those allied health programs requiring clinical courses (or practicums), clinical tracking systems are very beneficial to both students and instructors. Trajecsys is a clinical and assessment tracking system that tracks students' forms/records, clinical schedules, clinical participation and attendance, and attainment of competencies. Clinical tracking helps faculty monitor clinical learning and supports reporting to accrediting bodies. The annual cost for HESI runs about \$5400 and about \$2700 for Trajecsys. The cost will be covered by 18 students over multiple terms.
