BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The District is seeking a qualified Pizza provider to deliver 86 pizzas, each school day, to designated school sites for lunch sales. The ingredients must meet the USDA nutritional requirements for schools to be considered. The District had contracted with Domino's through 2022, then after an RFP in 2022, has been contracted with Papa Johns for the past two years. Due to a price increase from \$6.50 to a proposed \$9.99 per pizza, the District went out to RFP with Papa Johns being the only bidder. After a Food Service audit, the

auditor recommended we go out to bid immediately and include the termination clause and contract work hours and safety standards since this contract is paid for with Federal dollars. Sealed Proposals were received by the district on March 20th at 2:00 p.m. The committee will evaluate the submitted bids on March 21st in advance of the School Board meeting.

Service Providers were scored on the following criteria: Price (50 points) Ability to meet the District's Needs (20 points) Reputation of Vendor Services (20 points) Quality of Vendors Response (10 points)

The committee reviewing the proposals was: Jeff Atkinson, Food Service Director Tammy Childers, Secretary to the Food Service Director Andrea Young, Assistant Director for Food Service

RECOMMENDATION:

The Committee will collaborate on March 21st, to evaluate and score the proposals based on the published criteria. The Committee will recommend the top-ranked proposer at the March 24th School Board meeting.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Budget expectations are roughly \$10 dollars per 8-slice pizza. The slices will in turn be served as the entrée portion for reimbursable school lunches. 2024-25 Fiscal Year Spent: \$122,627.
