



CCC 2024 BOND - PROJECTS UPDATE - 9/4/25

Natural Resources Center of Excellence

- An RFP is scheduled for release mid-September for a Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC). This approach brings the contractor into the team early and they will help with estimating, systems selection and constructability review.
- A Memorandum of Understanding has been executed to support the CCC partnership with OSU Extension Service for their involvement in the project.
- Project Leadership groups have been meeting with Opsis Architecture to identify program needs for CCC and OSU Extension Service.
- Groundbreaking is targeted for summer of 2026 with completion late 2027 or spring of 2028.

Walking Trail

- Design package is now with the City for land use approval.
- Project will go out for bids in December/January with completion due late spring.

Athletic Facilities

- The design process continues with possible construction start in October of this year, with planned completion before next season. Groundbreaking event opportunity.
- Includes new grandstands, press boxes, restrooms, soccer field, track, baseball and softball improvements.
- Project has been submitted for land use approval.

<u>Deferred Maintenance/Energy Efficiency/Decentralization</u>

- A building envelope (exterior walls and roofs) study has been completed and will be used to support prioritization of projects to be done with bond funds.
- Mazzetti, an engineering firm, is underway on developing a prioritized master plan for HVAC/Plumbing and Electrical projects.
- Non-dimming LED lighting conversions in public spaces will be installed over the next year.
- Pneumatic Controls upgrades in Barlow/Randall/Old Wacheno/McLoughlin/Pauling A are under contract and scheduled to complete spring of 2026.
- Air Handler Coil Cleaning is being analyzed by Energy Trust of Oregon. Potential incentives.
- Barlow IT Server Room HVAC upgrades are scheduled to complete by the end of 2025.
- The majority of the exterior storefronts at Barlow will be replaced. Project procured and will be installed summer of 2026 after materials arrive.
- Recently acquired 30-acres on Beavercreek fencing, moving and coordination with BPA.

Wacheno Re-Roof Project





- Work is underway, with a target work completion prior to '25/'26 school year start.
- Painting of the old, faded and peeling fascia sheet metal was recently added to the contract.

Welding Expansion

• This project will follow the NRCE building project due to existing WET Lab program at the west end of the building moving into the new facility.

Maintenance Yard Renovations

- ZCS is progressing well, currently with City for Planning Department approval.
- Project targeted to bid December/January with work targeted to complete summer of 2026.

McLoughlin and Dye

- McLoughlin and Dye are under consideration for a bundled project.
- Depending on timing, the Pathways and Plaza project might be included as well.
- Timeline under discussion, design could potentially start end of 2025.

Access Control/Safety

- Barlow security cameras are being installed now, with door access control after door improvement project occurs.
- Vehicle gates are being installed on Douglas Loop to allow for closing the campus if needed.
- Planning is underway for Pauling Buildings.
- Yellow Lot camera work is being initiated this month.

IT Scope

- ITS is close to the completion of the student facing computer deployments, the team is 80% complete with the project.
- Harmony East nursing simulation lab upgrade is now scheduled to take place from September 8 September 19.
- IT infrastructure needs (servers & networking) are still being evaluated.

Challenger Center

 This unique project will convert the south end of Clairmont Hall into an interactive space experience for middle school students. It is being planned for a construction start after the programs vacate the space into the new NRCE building, early 2028.

 Planning for community outreach on interests and needs. Discussions underway on PGE's usage and agreement on this campus. Additionally, there are discussions underway with Wilsonville City Leaders.
