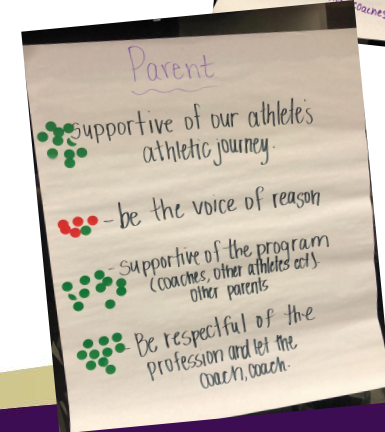
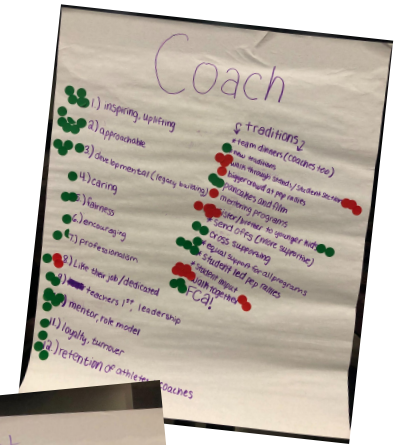
Athletic Advisory Committee
