Subject: Renewal of RFP #2820-21 - Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance

Background Information:

 The Board of Trustees awarded RFP #2820-21 Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance on June 14, 2021. If approved, this renewal would be the final year of a possible five-year term.

- Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance is a type of insurance coverage available for
 employers that choose to self-insure the majority of workers' compensation loss exposure.
 Two categories of coverages are available: specific, which controls loss severity by placing a
 cap on losses the insured must pay arising out of a single occurrence (the self-insured
 retention SIR), and aggregate, which addresses loss frequency by providing coverage once
 a cumulative per occurrence loss limit is breached.
- LISD's current Third-Party Administration (TPA) policy is a combination of coverages, both specific and aggregate, with a \$500,000 self-insured retention.

Administrative Consideration:

- If approved, funds for this expenditure will come from the Benefits Department general operating budget.
- Previous annual expenditures:

0 2024-2025: \$179,808

- Estimated annual expenditures: \$183,427 but will not exceed the approved budget.
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code.

Recommendations:

 That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the renewal of RFP #2820-21 Excess Workers' Compensation Insurance contract and the estimated expenditures for one year with the recommended vendor.
