Deadline: All nominations must be received between **April 21st and May 2nd**.

Nomination Requirements

According to Board Policy, a facility may be named for:

- A living or deceased person who has attained local or national prominence in education, science, art, statesmanship, political science, or military achievement
- An early pioneer of the Goose Creek CISD area or the state of Texas
- An outstanding President of the United States

Students and citizens are encouraged to nominate individuals who reflect the diversity of our community. Each nomination must include three paragraphs outlining:

1. Biographical information
2. The nominee's significant contributions
3. A statement explaining why the field house should bear their name

Citizen Participation Opportunity

Community members are encouraged to present their nomination during **Citizen's Participation (6:00 p.m.) at the May 6, 2025, Board Meeting**. Presentations will be limited to three minutes per person, with a maximum of five speakers per nomination.

The **Board of Trustees may or may not take action on the name at the June 2, 2025, meeting**.
