Background Information

The Duncanville ISD Police Department is responsible for the safety and security of students, staff, and visitors across all district campuses. As part of the district's ongoing commitment to campus safety and officer accountability, the department conducted a formal evaluation of body-worn camera (BWC) platforms to identify the best long-term solution for the department.

Three vendors were evaluated across six criteria: officer safety, evidence management, technology integration, long-term sustainability, transparency and accountability, and total cost of ownership. All three vendors submitted formal quotes for a 10-camera, 60-month deployment. After thorough review, the department recommends Axon as the superior platform based on its integrated public safety ecosystem, regional interoperability with Dallas PD and Duncanville PD, real-time situational awareness capabilities through Axon Fusus, CJIS-compliant evidence management through Evidence.com, and a clear upgrade path.
