TOPIC: LCTC Technology Purchase

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of new Chromebook, Chromebook carts, and Google Chrome EDU Licenses for LCTC and specific programs through 61a (added cost) funds.

RATIONALE:

The Livonia Career Technical Center (LCTC) is requesting to purchase new Chromebooks, Chromebook carts, and Google Chrome EDU licenses for general use at LCTC and for specific programs through 61a (equipment over \$5,000) funds. Through contract pricing the total cost for the Chromebooks, Chromebook carts, and Google Chrome EDU licenses is \$56,764.45 through People Driven Technology (Byron Center, MI).

Below is list of programs who will be utilizing this purchase for instructional and learning purposes; as well as the quote for these items within said program:

- Criminal Justice (30 Chromebooks with license) = \$10,019.70
- Construction Trades (30 Chromebooks with cart and license) = \$11,268.70
- Health Sciences (60 Chromebooks with cart and license, for 2 classrooms (\$11,268.70 each)) = \$22,537.40
- LCTC (35 Chromebooks with cart and license) = \$12,938.65
- Total Cost = \$56,764.45
