What We Know

SB 546

This bill, which was passed in the regular session of the 89th Texas Legislature, applies to the requirement for school buses to include three-point seat belts for each passenger, regardless of model year.









Must present status of the school bus fleet to the school board before May 2026.

Districts must report this information to TEA. No guidance on how at this time.

January 2027 TEA is presenting this collective data to the 90th legislative session for review.

September 1, 2029 all school buses are to be equipped with 3 point seatbelts.


