EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Texas Education Code (TEC), §28.023, allows students in primary grades to accelerate a grade level and students in secondary academic courses to earn credit for a course on the basis of credit by examination. Credit-by-examination assessments (CBEs) must be approved by each local board of trustees.

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) allows the University of Texas High School and Texas Tech University K-12 to develop exams that are designed by curriculum experts and aligned to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for Credit by Exam.
