Available rate days are Sunday, March 14th through Wednesday, March 17th. Do not use the website for your reservations, call the highlighted number only. If you did not respond but would still like to join us, that will be ok. Please contact the Northern for your reservations.

Due to the agreement with the Northern Hotel, the rates for rooms are as follows: (Montana State Rates will not apply)

- Classic King Room (sleeps 2): \$129/night
