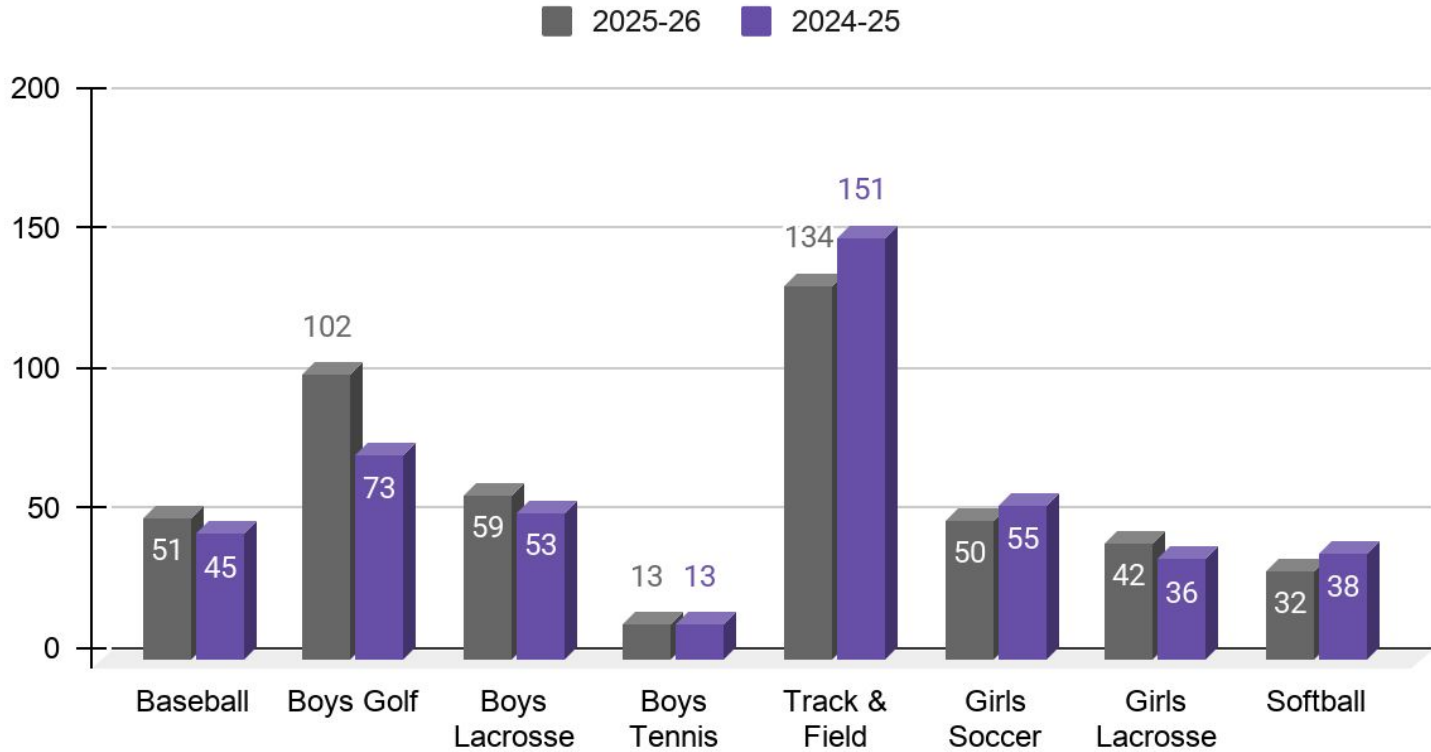

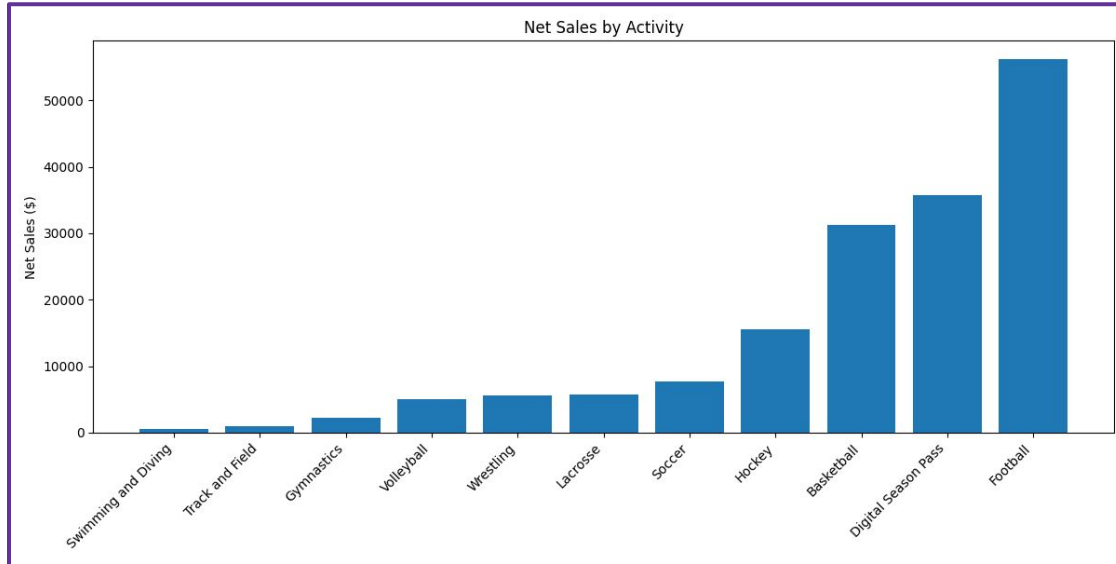

Gate Receipts

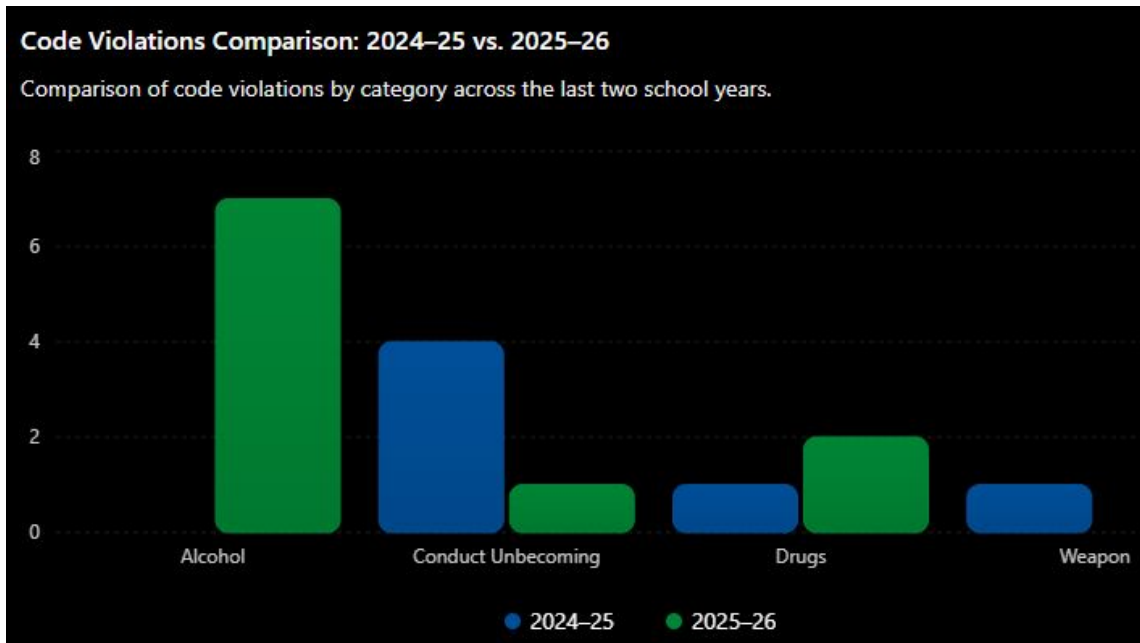


- Football remained the top revenue generator in both years, but this year's net sales (\$56,148) declined compared to last year's \$61,707 – a decrease of about 9%.
 - One less home game this year compared to last year.
- Basketball showed strong growth, increasing from \$26,102 last year to \$31,288 this year (approximately 20% growth), while Hockey also improved significantly from \$10,107 to \$15,561, making it one of the largest percentage gains among all activities.
- Importance of these sales
 - Supply budget (subsidize)



Co-Curricular Code Violations

- Alcohol violations increased significantly this year.
- Overall, this year's violations were more concentrated around alcohol-related incidents, while last year's incidents were more varied across categories.
