1. Welcome:

2. Enrollment is 81, down 5 from the beginning of the year
 - a. K/1 - 25 (12 kinder - 13 - 1st)
 - b. 2nd - 19
 - c. 3rd - 16
 - d. 4/5 - 21 (11 - 4th and 10 - 5th)
3. We split the 2/3 class at the end of October.
 - a. Current projection for 2/3 in 2026/2027 would be 32 students. We are in discussions to determine if we will be able to continue with separate classes for the 26/27 school year.
