## Principal's General Narrative:

High School summer school ended June 19, 2025. Teachers worked very hard to get our students ready for the upcoming academic school year 2025-2026. All core areas were targeted – Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Intervention time was provided for students to meet TEA requirements. TEA requires supplemental accelerated instruction for students not performing satisfactory on state assessments. High School students worked on preparing for the summer EOC administration. Students tested from July 16 to July 19.

Students continue to use open gyms for strengthening and conditioning. We are getting ready for the new school year. Summer cleaning and waxing floors continues at BISD. Our custodial staff and maintenance department are working diligently to get our buildings in shape for the start of the school year. Currently, we are working on the master schedule. All vacancies needed have been filled. Some changes to the master schedule next year:

- 9 periods during the day instead of 8
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Period will be "Tiger Period." This period will be used for partial planning for teachers and partial student interventions. Teachers will be able to pull small groups and work on deficient areas.
- All 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will get a double dosage of ELA and Math every day.
