

What's New with the School Board?



Student Outcomes don't change until adult behaviors change.

What's New with the School Board?

- LSG = scholarships to Board for due diligence to LSG process
- . Board approved TASB salary audit to review employee compensation (except Supt's.). Board looks to take care of employees and employee's families, ultimately improving the district and community
- . Improved communication and transparency
- Approval of education fund that falls under a non-profit 501(c)3 category

Student Outcomes don't change until adult behaviors change.

What's New with the Administration?

- Leadership transition has been relatively smooth
- New leadership
 - Supt., Asst. Supt, Secondary Principal,
 Secondary Asst. Principal, and Elementary
 Principal
 - Business Manager, Instructional Coach,
 Information Technology Director, and Central Office
- Improved visibility
- Improved communication and transparency
- . Improved approachability
- RCISD partnerships with Roscoe Police Department and City of Roscoe

What's New with Academics?

- Enrollment numbers are slightly up
- Working with LSOA on accountability while maintaining additional funds to school district (uncertain of actual amounts, but we suspect about \$2 million)
- Improved Instructional Style in lower grades
- Secondary Accountability
 - Excelling in CCR
 - Still working through other areas
