BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On November 30, 2012, Commissioner of Education Michael L. Williams announced that, for the 2012-13 school year, districts may defer implementation of the statutory provision that requires performance on an end-of-course (EOC) assessment to count as 15 percent of a student's final course grade.

ITEM ADDRESSED:

We would like to suspend for the remainder of the 2012-13 school year portions of the following codes:

EIA(LOCAL), at END-OF-COURSE ASSESSMENTS, requiring a student's performance on an EOC assessment to count for 15 percent of a student's final grade for the course and addressing other related provisions regarding the 15 percent provision; and

EIC(LOCAL), at END-OF COURSE ASSESSMENT SCORES, addressing EOC assessments and calculation of class rank.
