Contract Award Recommendation – District Wide Roof Assessment Project

Dear Mr. Francis:

This letter transmits an update from Plante Moran Cresa (PMC) as it relates to the assignment to assist and advise Livonia Public Schools (LPS) in its selection of a Professional Services Firm for the Project listed above. This update represents the mutual efforts of PMC and LPS administration and staff (the Project Team) to present a framework in order to identify, evaluate and recommend a Professional Services Firm for this Project.

On April 4, 2017, a Request for Proposals was issued and made available to a preselected list of five (5) firms specializing in this area of work. It should be noted that this work is considered a professional service and is not required to be publicly bid.

On April 18, 2017, four (4) bid proposals were received for the Project, and over the next several weeks were thoroughly reviewed. Interviews were conducted on April 28th and were attended by representatives from PMC and LPS. The scope of work, project schedule, related K-12 experience, manpower requirements, and other particulars regarding the work were reviewed and discussed.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after subsequent clarifications and discussions, the Team is recommending Roofing Technology Associates, LTD (RTA) for contract award. RTA is currently working in the district on the high school projects, has strong experience in the K-12 industry, and is also located in Livonia. The Team also felt that their proposal included the necessary amount of time and manpower required to undertake an engagement of this magnitude. This contract award recommendation is for a total of \$59,700.00, including reimbursables.

The costs for this work will be detailed in a Roofing Consulting Services Agreement between LPS and RTA, pending final review and approval of terms by district's legal counsel.
