




WHAT: Third Grade Reading Goal Fountas and Pinnell



- We serve many students very well; however, some students are not benefitting from smaller class sizes, new resources, etc.
- We continue to see a large variance in results at some grade levels
- Our achievement gap with our special education subgroup reflects a need for intense work in this area

- Collaboration through PLC's will be an area of focus
- Year-long professional learning with coaching for co-teaching pairs
