**Background Information:**

- In the fall of 2026, the Board of Trustees approved the creation of 2025-26 board advisory committees, including the Citizens Bond Advisory and Long-Range Planning committees.
- In January, those two committees began meeting jointly to review Keller ISD’s financial outlook, demographics projections, campus utilization figures, and other metrics to have conversations about creating more efficiency in district operations through consolidating some KISD schools.
- In February, committee members voted to prioritize criteria that district administrators should consider when developing a plan for school consolidation.
- Throughout March, district leadership used the committee’s criteria to map out a plan that would address the committee’s priorities while minimizing the impact to families and employees.
- That proposal was shared with the committees at a joint meeting on April 2, where additional feedback was collected.
- The proposal was posted for community review and collection of feedback.
