Split/Share the Superintendent position with another school district (Savings of \$50,000-\$60,000)

Transition After-School Academic Support to Online Homework help (this would eliminate some Late Ride transportation costs)

Combine the School Nurse positions (Savings \$25,000-\$30,000)

Our district generates roughly \$18,000 per pupil. \$18,000 x 308 students will equal about 5.5 million dollars in revenue. Plus, other miscellaneous revenue from the County, Donations, Ticket Sales, Federal Government etc...round out the revenues for our school district.
