The following is a sequence of events pertaining to the canvassing of the November 4, 2014 School Board of Trustees Election at an open public meeting:

1. The newly elected trustees must sign and file the *Statement of Elected Officer*. The document will be signed and filed with the local custodians of election records.
2. Section 67.004(a) of the Election Code states: "two (2) members of the authority constitute a quorum for purposes of canvassing an election." The Election must be canvassed at the earliest Wednesday, November 12, 2014 but no later than Tuesday, November 18, 2014.
3. Upon completing the canvassing of the Election each elected Trustee shall be issued a *Certificate of Election* and becomes eligible to take the official *Oath of Office*.
4. Finally, a newly elected Trustee takes the Oath of Office and assumes the duties of office.
