TAG Identification Process

Current:

- 1. Referral made to TAG by parent or teacher
- 2. Work samples gathered from classroom teachers
- 3. Renzulli and Sages, conducted individually by School Psychologists
- 4. Children with scores at or above STAR Math and Language Arts Benchmark
- 5. TAG Team reviews data and makes determination in January/February

Proposed:

- 1. CogAT administered school-wide to all Grade 3 students
- 2. Students scoring at or above locally developed norms will be considered for TAG
- 3. The TAG Committee will review additional data /resources for any child close to the locally developed norms, by 10 points, on the CogAT to determine if eligibility should be considered. (see # 2, 3, 4 above as options)

Parents are notified. A group PPT will be held.

The CogAT has been developed to assess student's abilities in reasoning and problem solving using verbal, quantitative, and non-verbal symbols. It can assist in making student placement decisions such as selecting students for gifted and talented programs. * (*Taken from Houghton Mifflin Harcourt web site's test description)
