

High School Summer School Program 2020

Background:

For the current year, the Belmond-Klemme district levies an additional 74¢ per \$1,000 of assessed valuation to generate \$213,252 to spend on assisting at-risk students and trying to prevent students from dropping out of school. A small but significant part of our At-risk/Dropout Prevention Program is our Belmond-Klemme summer school program.

Normally, high school summer school runs the last three weeks of June with students attending on campus.

COVID-19 Changes:

Due to the pandemic, we are planning for online summer school. Rather than scheduling 20 days for students to attend in classrooms, summer school teacher Patrick Kelley is planning for a flexible summer. The majority of students will be working in June; however, some may take longer and extend their hours into July.

Terms of employment for the summer will be calculated based upon what he has done in the past, which is working seven-hour days from 8:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M. for twenty days. His salary is calculated in the table below:
