- 12/18/14 Letter addressed to Chair Miernicki, Members of the Board, and Superintendent Gronseth from Barb Hauck expressing her concern that education does not seem to be the priority of all school board members, and her concern over the behaviors of some board members. Ms. Hauck expresses appreciation and hope that action taken Dec 2, 2014 will result in board meetings where the education of our children is again the primary issue on the agenda.
- 01/28/15 Letters addressed to Superintendent Gronseth and Duluth School Board from teachers from Denfeld High School's departments of English and Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies, expressing appreciation for the opportunity to meet regularly as departments in Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) to improve student achievement.
