 ✓Full year of science at grade 7

Implementation Time Line

- Proposed changes 2011-12
 - \checkmark Science moves to full year at grade 7
 - ✓ Art, FACS, IT, Business credit requirements at grade 7 move to .25 each
 - ✓ Elective credit choices at grade 8 move from 1.5 to 2.0; drop .5 credit requirement for Art and FACS; drop World Language for Music offerings
 - ✓ Elective credit choices at grade 9 move from 2.0 to 2.5; drop .5 credit requirement for Business and FACS/IT
