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Building GRIT - One Challenge at a Time

Middle school is a time when students begin facing more challenges, both academically and socially. One of the most valuable skills they can develop during this stage is perseverance—the ability to keep going, even when things feel tough.

Parents can support perseverance at home by encouraging students to view mistakes as opportunities to learn rather than as



failures. Remind them that growth comes from effort and persistence, not just quick success.

Celebrate the process of "sticking with it" as much as the final outcome.

Practical tips:

- Ask your child to share one challenge they faced during the week and what they did to work through it.
- Praise effort ("I noticed you kept trying, even when it was hard") as much as results.
- Model perseverance by sharing stories of challenges you've overcome.

When students learn to push through obstacles, they build resilience and confidence—skills that will serve them for a lifetime.




