Purpose of Report

The Purpose of this Report is to inform the Board of Trustees of a plan to integrate energy efficient and conservation principles into some of Denton ISD's facilities. This plan includes the following:

- 1) Provide irrigation controllers at Guyer High School for the purposes of monitoring water usage and to afford a more user friendly system for staff.
- 2) Continue to improve and upgrade the District's Energy Management System through HVAC (heating, ventilating and air conditioning) controls upgrades.
- 3) Continue with the replacement of inefficient light fixtures; replacing many T12 fixtures with T8 fixtures and reflectors. This installation provides more light with less energy.
- 4) Provide occupancy sensors and timer switches within existing facilities. These devices allow the lights to be turned off automatically when the space is not in use.
- 5) Upgrade emergency lighting fixtures to maintain a safe environment for students and staff.

Objectives

- Provide the District with a means to monitor water consumption on a real time basis and adjust schedules as needed for a more efficient use of resources.
- Integrate high performance or green technologies within existing District facilities.
- Continue to address and meet state mandated goals for energy reduction.
- Provide safe learning environments for students, staff and public.

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Operational Impact

Scope: Smart Controls – irrigation system at Guyer High School

Cost: \$107,908.00

Schedule: The work will be completed by August 1, 2010

Scope: HVAC Control upgrades at Denton & Ryan High School

Cost: \$43,299.00

Schedule: The work will be completed by August 1, 2010

Scope: Lighting Retrofits, Occupancy Sensor / Switches & Emergency Fixtures

Cost: \$1,169,461.00

Schedule: The work will be completed by August 1, 2010

Funding for these projects can be taken from remaining Phase I projects that have been closed out. Work will take place during the evenings and over spring break.
