Standard Terms and Conditions

- 1. **Consultation Services.** The ESC hereby agrees to perform for the CLIENT responsibilities and tasks as described in the Scope of Work.
- 2. **Compliance With Laws.** ESC and CLIENT agree to observe and comply with all applicable Federal, State, and County laws, regulations and ordinances as related to the responsibilities set forth in the Scope of Work.
- 3. **Term of Agreement.** This agreement is effective from the first service date to the end service date specified in the agreement summary. This agreement may be extended or otherwise amended only by formal written amendment properly executed by both the ESC and CLIENT. No other agreement, written or oral, purporting to alter or amend this agreement shall be valid.
- 4. **Time Devoted by ESC**. It is anticipated the ESC will fulfill the obligations under this agreement on an as needed basis. The particular amount of time devoted to the agreed upon tasks or services will vary based upon the extent and nature of the particular project.
- 5. **Payment to ESC.** The ESC will be paid at the following rate as stipulated for work performed in accordance with this agreement.
- 6. **Termination.** This agreement may be terminated by either party at any time for good reason upon fifteen calendar days written notice to the other party. Expenditures, work activity, and or products for which ESC may claim payment will be billed to the CLIENT within fifteen (15) days of termination. The reasonable monetary value of services properly performed by ESC pursuant to this agreement prior to termination shall be paid to ESC as soon as reasonably possible.
- 7. **Independent Contractor.** Both the ESC and the CLIENT agree that the ESC will act as an independent contractor in the performance of its duties under this agreement. Accordingly, any ESC personnel assigned to this project shall have no entitlement as a CLIENT employee.
- 8. **Confidential Information**. The ESC and CLIENT agrees that any information received by either party during any furtherance of the obligations in accordance with this agreement, which concerns the personal, financial or other affairs of either party will be treated by each party in full confidence and will not be revealed to any other persons, firms or organizations.
- 9. **Ownership of work product.** All technical data, evaluations, plans, specifications, reports, documents, power point presentations, software, spreadsheets, teaching aids, or other work products developed by ESC provided hereunder shall be the exclusive property of ESC. CLIENT may retain copies thereof for its files and internal use. Publication of the information directly derived from work performed or data obtained in connection with services rendered under this Agreement must first be approved in writing by ESC.

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- 10. **Unfair Business Practices**. By signing this agreement both ESC and CLIENT certify that within the preceding 12 months, neither party has been found guilty, in a judicial or state agency administrative proceeding, of unfair business practices. Both ESC and CLIENT also certify that no officer of its company has, within the preceding 12 months, served as an officer in another company which has been found, in a judicial or state agency administrative proceeding, to be guilty of unfair business practices.
- 11. **Use of Funds.** By signing this agreement, both ESC and CLIENT agree that no funds provided pursuant to this agreement shall be used by either party for any political activity or PAC contribution and that both parties are prohibited from using such funds for influencing or attempting to influence any member of Congress or its employees or any federal agency employee concerning the making or awarding of a federal grant.
- 12. **Notice of Felony Conviction.** By signing this agreement, both ESC and CLIENT certify that neither they, the owner of their company, or operator of their business have been convicted of a felony, nor are any of the named persons presently debarred, suspended, proposed for disbarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in this proposed agreement by any Federal or State Department or Agency.
- 13. **Indemnification.** To the extent permitted by Texas Law, CLIENT shall indemnify and hold harmless ESC, its governing board members, officers, and employees against any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, proceedings, losses, costs and damages, including any reasonable attorney fees and/or litigation expenses, which may be brought or made against or incurred by the ESC on account of loss or of damage to any property or for injuries to or death of any person caused by the action of the CLIENT, its officers, and/or employees in connection with this agreement. The obligation of the CLIENT under this section will not extend to any liability caused by the sole negligence or acts of the ESC or its employees.
- 14. Nondiscrimination in employment, services, benefits and facilities.

By signing this agreement:

- A. Both ESC and CLIENT agree and that they shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local Anti-discrimination laws, regulations, and ordinances and to not unlawfully discriminate, harass, or allow harassment against any employee, applicant for employment, employee or agent of either party, or recipient of services contemplated to be provided or provided under this Agreement, because of race, ancestry, marital status, color, religious creed, political belief, national origin, ethnic group identification, sex, sexual orientation, age (over 40), medical condition (including HIV and AIDS), or physical or mental disability.
- 15. **Insurance.** Without limiting CLIENT'S indemnification, both ESC and CLIENT shall procure and maintain for the duration of the agreement, insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the performance of the agreement by CLIENT, its agents, representatives or employees.
