Hello Evergreen Friends and Family,

As spring approaches, many of our classrooms are beginning to take some field trips and have class activities that may require parent involvement. If you are planning on volunteering to chaperone a field trip or help out at the school, please make sure that you have filled out the Volunteer Application in the main office and turned it back into Molly Kitchens. After your application has been turned in, Molly will contact you to verify that your name has been added to the volunteer list and that you may start helping out in the class or on field trips. If you are not on the list or do not know, please check in with Molly in the main office about this process.

The first round of OAKS testing is coming to an end for grades 3-5. Staff will start to look at the data to drive instruction and support individual needs. Students will have a 2nd opportunity to take the reading and/or math test(s), if they did not pass the first time. Remember, we look for individual student growth in relations to where each student is academically; taking into account scores from last year's OAKS test(s) and other assessments routinely given throughout the school year in order to see the overall growth for each student.

The lower grades are continuing to support each student and their needs academically, behaviorally, and socially. The K-2 teachers use other assessments like DIBELS, AR Reading, and/or daily assessments to guide their instruction.

Please keep supporting your student(s) in doing their best on a daily basis at school.

Emma Smith received a bronze at the district level and all the other district participants received a participation award.

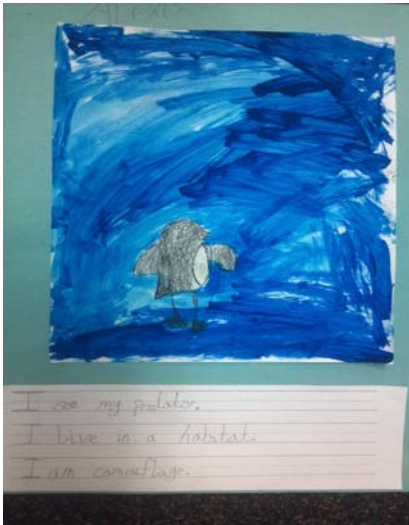

Child Find for Special Education

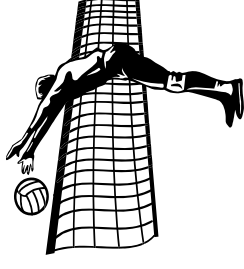
