Reading Specialist:

- Walk to Read/Walk to Learn at TCE will begin Tuesday, September 8th. Kindergarten students will remain in their rooms and be supported in literacy activities. First and second grade will be partnered for “Walk to Read”, literacy only. Grades 3-6 will be a “Walk to Learn” model, which will include intervention/enrichment in both literacy and math.
 - **Targeted instruction:** Students can be grouped by specific reading needs rather than only by grade level.
 - **Efficient use of staff:** Teachers can specialize in different reading skills or intervention areas. Specialists can be utilized by their strengths as well.
 - **Cross-grade collaboration:** Older and younger students can benefit from positive reading interactions and peer modeling.
 - **Enrichment opportunities:** Students who are already meeting grade-level expectations can receive advanced reading, writing, vocabulary, or literature activities instead of additional intervention.
 - **Flexible grouping:** Groups can change as students’ skills and needs change.
 - **Builds a culture of literacy:** Reading becomes a shared schoolwide priority rather than something confined to individual classrooms.

A key advantage is that **students are not limited by their assigned grade-level classroom for literacy instruction**. They can receive either **intervention or enrichment based on their demonstrated needs**, while still returning to their regular classroom for core instruction.
