### **Project Development Agreement Options**

### Districtwide PDA (includes every campus within EPISD)

- Addresses multiple facility needs & comfort issues quickly
- Maximize Energy Savings to address facility issues
- Every campus receives facility benefit (LED Lighting)

### Multiple Phase Approach (Phase I & Phase II Approach)

- Only include half of the District now in Phase I
- Remainder of facilities in District in Phase II after Phase I construction.
- In our professional opinion, this option is not the best use of EPISD's money due to dollars still being spent on utilities that could have been used on needed EPISD facility needs.
