Introduction to the School Board

Thanks for your interest in the work of the Umatilla School Board. This guide (English Spanish) to a Board meeting is a helpful resource for understanding the roles and responsibilities of the School Board and meeting structure. If you attend a meeting in person and wish to speak, please complete a comment card (printed copies are available at the meeting). Public comment is also accepted via online survey. New survey responses are shared with the board each meeting. It can be helpful to review the Board Staff Operating Principles document to understand the roles of the board and the roles of the superintendent and staff. The Board does not respond during public comment but may utilize information given during future decisions. Board policies are available online and the system is searchable by keyword.

Personnel Concerns

As per Umatilla School District Board Policy BDDH speakers may offer objective criticism of district operations and programs, but the Board will not hear complaints concerning individual district personnel. Please see the <u>Umatilla School District complaint procedure</u> for formal complaints.

Agendas and Packets

While board agendas and packets are always posted 24 hours ahead of the meeting and available via Board Book, it can be difficult to know what might be coming up to know if it's worthwhile to view the livestream or attend a meeting.
