The Digital Teaching & Learning Department is requesting approval to continue our partnership with **SchoolAI**, an AI-powered educational platform that has become an integral part of our district's teaching and learning environment.

Over the past year, SchoolAl has been widely adopted across our schools, with high levels of teacher and student usage. The platform has proven to be a valuable tool in enhancing student learning, streamlining teacher workflows, and providing meaningful data insights that help track and support student progress. In addition, the SchoolAl team has been highly responsive and supportive as a provider, working closely with us to ensure smooth implementation and ongoing success.

Based on this positive experience, we are recommending the renewal of a **10-month contract** for SchoolAI, covering the period from **September 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026**. The cost remains the same as last year at **\$4.30 per student**, reflecting our current enrollment, for a total of **\$142,330.00**. This ensures that every student and educator in our district will continue to have full access to this platform.

We believe maintaining this partnership will allow us to build on the strong foundation established this past year and further advance our efforts in integrating AI responsibly and effectively into teaching and learning.
