4. AGENDA:

A. Receive information on the Medicaid Network Access Improvement Program (NAIP) organized and operated by the Texas Health and Human Services

Commission (HHSC) for the purposes of increasing Medicaid managed care members' access to primary and specialty care and related services from providers affiliated with public hospital; NAIP authorized by 83rd Session

Texas legislature, General Appropriations Act, Article II, Riders 79 and 80 - INFORMATION

Mr. Hipp stated in principle the Network Access Improvement Program (NAIP) is an additional supplemental payment program to provide IGTs to help Spohn obtain additional payments for Medicaid enrollees. The federal matching funds are paid to a managed care company via HHSC. Locally there are three managed care companies that have contracts with the state to administer the state's Medicaid program. The three HMO's that contract with Spohn are Superior, United and Christus Health Plan. However, Spohn must meet the state's performance and objectives otherwise they'll lose funding if they fail to fulfill the performance and objectives as contracted with the managed care company. He further stated Christus Spohn is the only public hospital in Corpus Christi that qualifies for NAIP funding.

It is important to note that if NCHD enters into an agreement with HHSC, our IGT funds become mandatory and not voluntary.

B. Receive information on NAIP projects proposed to HHSC by CHRISTUS

Spohn Hospital Corpus Christi for the term September 1, 2016 - August 31,

2017 - INFORMATION

Ms. Chapa reported that Spohn currently has contracts with the following managed care companies: Superior, United and Christus Health Plan. A brief discussion followed relating to the overall impact of providing additional

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programs that will improve access to preventive care, continuity of care and assist patients in seeking care in an appropriate settings. Spohn will implement a patient navigator program that will focus primarily on the high emergency department utilizer patient population. Overall it's important to know the impact this funding will bring into the our patient population assures that no one is denied admission and assistance in navigating through the program for all enrollees.

C. Adopt Board of Managers Resolution authorizing the Administrator to execute a NAIP IGT Responsibility Agreement with HHSC to facilitate CHRISTUS Spohn Hospital Corpus Christi's participation in NAIP for the term September 1, 2016 - August 31, 2017 - ACTION

On motion by Mr. Jennings, seconded by Mr. Corrigan, the Board of Managers adopted a resolution authorizing the Administrator to execute a Network Access Improvement Program (NAIP) Intergovernmental Transfers (IGT) Responsibility Agreement with HHSC to facilitate CHRISTUS Spohn Hospital Corpus Christi's participation in NAIP for the term September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017.

On the same motion and second, the Board of Managers agreed to approve The Responsibility Agreement in principle and before its execution at Mr. Jennings request the updated Agreement shall be reviewed.
