Parkrose Middle School Discipline Data Summary 2014-2015

- Overall Hispanic referrals were significantly down compared to last year
- Black referrals are up from last year
 - Black boys are down from last year
 - Black girls are up significantly
- Mixed race referrals are up significantly
 - We had two boys who fell into this category
 - Both students were placed in alternative settings by the end of the year
- Both Middle School and High School had new Student Management Support (SMS) people
 - Adjustment to position
 - Adjustment to the discipline system in place
 - Relationship building with staff and students
- Integration of i-pads caused for increase in referrals
- Additional two weeks of school year compared to 2013-2014 school year
- Data includes both In-School and Out of School suspension information
- We are using our In School Suspension room as a place for students to refocus, review expectations and return to class.

Parkrose High School Discipline Data Summary 2014-2015

Referrals were up across the board -- in previous year, staff had the impression that they were not to write referrals. In the month of November, a meeting was held with staff in which they were encouraged to write more referrals if they were feeling things weren't being handled. In that month alone, nearly 200 referrals were written compared to every other month being approximately 60.
