The month of July average numbers served at the production sites were about 269 for breakfast and about 1,058 for lunch at 15 days currently.

Every Wednesday we had a barbeque at both sites for lunch and BES had our slide, jumpy house. It's been a big draw on those days.

Every Friday was the same for the supper program.

The Vision's Volunteers have had carnival games, soccer, hula hoops, and prizes for all of the children who come to eat at the sites the past few days.

The Children's Day was on July 11, 2018 at the All Chief's Park and that was a huge success with a total of 467 children that ate at the Child Nutrition food mobile.

July 12th and July13th we had the food mobile and the food bus at the North American Indian Days Celebration and we fed about 294 children total.
