Background	On May 20, 2025, quotes were solicited to provide recurring grounds
	maintenance services at Crosby High School, Crosby Middle School,
	Crosby Elementary, Barrett Elementary, Drew Elementary, Newport
	Elementary, Crosby Kindergarten Center, the Operations Center, and the
	administration building. Quotes were received from two companies with
	Metropolitan Landscape providing the best value to the District.
	The proposed grounds maintenance would include 42 visits during the
	year and include mowing, edging, and trimming. The proposal also
	includes annual tree-trimming and bi-annual mulch services.

_	baseball/softball complex. Current grounds employees will be tasked

Budget	The 2025-2026 General Fund budget will be used to cover the cost of the
