<b>Action</b>	Discuss and consider approval of a contract with Metropolitan Landscape to provide recurring grounds maintenance for an annual amount of \$251,370, via Choice Partners Cooperative contract 24/048MR.

<b>Administrative Recommendation</b>	Administration recommends approval of the contract with Metropolitan Landscape.
<b>Authority for this Action</b>	<p>Board Policy CH(LOCAL):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Board delegates to the Superintendent or designee the authority to make budgeted purchases for goods or services. However, any single, budgeted purchase of goods or services that costs \$50,000 or more, regardless of whether the goods or services are competitively purchased, shall require Board approval before a transaction may take place.</li></ul>
<b>Goal/Objective Addressed</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Crosby ISD will be a good steward of taxpayers' money.</li><li>• Crosby ISD will maintain quality and safe facilities.</li></ul>
<b>Background</b>	<p>On May 20, 2025, quotes were solicited to provide recurring grounds maintenance services at Crosby High School, Crosby Middle School, Crosby Elementary, Barrett Elementary, Drew Elementary, Newport Elementary, Crosby Kindergarten Center, the Operations Center, and the administration building. Quotes were received from two companies with Metropolitan Landscape providing the best value to the District.</p> <p>The proposed grounds maintenance would include 42 visits during the year and include mowing, edging, and trimming. The proposal also includes annual tree-trimming and bi-annual mulch services.</p>
<b>Staffing Implications</b>	Current grounds employees will maintain the football stadium and baseball/softball complex. Current grounds employees will be tasked with other maintenance projects throughout the district.
<b>Budget Information</b>	The 2025-2026 General Fund budget will be used to cover the cost of the contract.
<b>Impact of this Action</b>	Grounds maintenance will enhance the visual appeal of the district, create a positive and inspiring environment for students, staff, and community, while also helping to protect the district from the elements.
