SUBJECT: Boundary Recommendations for the West Field Cone

In November 2022, the board declared a boundary study open for the Weber, Fremont, and Roy school cones, including schools from both secondary and elementary levels, to create attendance boundaries for three new schools opening for the 2024-25 school year. Due to the potential number of students involved and modifications to high school, junior high school and elementary school boundaries, a Level III Boundary Adjustment was necessary. Level III adjustments are required when the process may involve two or more schools, a new school, and or re-balancing of student enrollments. Adjustments may affect the elementary, junior high and senior high levels simultaneously. As per Board Policy 4151, boundary study teams were formed at the district and school levels. A process was established to receive input from patrons and the public.

At the time of the most recent district boundary committee meeting the recommended proposals were as follows:

High School - Proposal 1 w/ 10th grade students grandfathered
Junior High - Proposal 2
Elementary - Proposal 2

Since the conclusion of the meetings and after onsite visits and additional feedback from community stakeholders, support shifted to recommend Elementary Proposal 3.
