Administrative Staff Development

The Board encourages and requires its administrative staff to be in a continual state of growth and development. The Board provides opportunities and resources for staff development in terms of professional dues, in-service training, workshops, conferences and released time to attend summer school.

The following criteria govern attendance at summer schools:

- 1. No more than half of the district principals will be permitted to attend summer school in any given year. An exception could be made to this rule when circumstances are such that it is necessary to have more principals in summer school provided a suitable work schedule can be arranged;
- 2. Principals who are required to attend summer school for administrator license renewal purposes will receive first priority;
- 3. When requirements for administrative license renewal are equal, those principals who attended summer school most recently will be considered eligible last;
- 4. It will be necessary for administrators to receive special superintendent permission when they plan to attend summer school in an area so far removed from the district that it will be impossible for them to assume part or all of their duties during the time they are enrolled in summer school.
