Education -

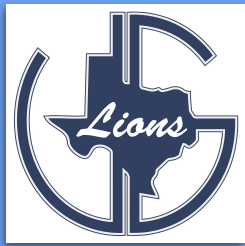
- annually UGISD requires all employees to complete online training on bullying prevention & intervention

Reporting -

- We have anonymous reporting at ugisd.org - anonymous incident reporting (David's Law)
- Each campus also has a locked box where students can write up reports anonymously

- [Bullying Checklist](#) provided by Texas School Safety Center is strictly used to determine if the act(s) are bullying or cyberbullying, based off of those findings discipline will be determined
- Facts will be shared with the parents or guardians of the students involved

Discipline

- Discipline will be based on the findings of the investigation and will follow the discipline matrix & legal policies & procedures
