SECTION 5. GENERAL WAIVER
Disciplinary Alternative Education Programs, pursuant to TEC 37.008(g). The district/campus improvement plan must conform to the requirements in TEC Section 11.252 and 11.253 and the Financial Accountability Resource Guide, 9.2.3. This waiver is granted for one year and the waiver must be resubmitted in writing by July 20 through the Texas Education Agency waiver office for each subsequent year, in accordance with TEA policies and deadlines for filing.
