- **February 13-15** Our fifth grade students attended Sky Ranch for the much anticipated three day science camp. Our students participated in many hands-on science based activities including forces of nature, ranch life, limnology, and challenges. They had a great time learning and having fun at the same time.
- **February 13/14** 3rd and 4th grade students took "mock" STAAR tests while the fifth grade students were gone to Sky Ranch. We will use the data from these benchmark tests to remediate based on weaknesses as determined by the data.
