**ITEM: VI.G.**

**TOPIC: Purchase of Furniture for Art Classrooms – 2013 Bond**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the purchase of elementary art room furniture from Interior Environments, Novi, Michigan in the amount of \$41,753.18 and Smith Systems, Plano, Texas in the amount of \$94,820.25 for a total purchase price of \$136,573.43.

**RATIONALE:**

The proposed furniture purchase consists of butcher block tables, stools, and chairs for elementary art classrooms. These would replace items that are more than 20 years old. Pricing comes from the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing agreement, formerly known as the National Joint Purchasing Agreement, which fulfills the Board's bidding requirement.
