## Board Resolution to Transfer Funds from General Fund to Student Activity Fund

## **HF602** General Fund Transfer to Student Activity

On May 10, 2021, Governor Reynolds signed HF602, which went into effect upon enactment. This legislation authorizes a school district's board of directors, through a board resolution, to transfer from the General Fund to the Student Activity Fund an amount necessary, as recommended by the superintendent, to fund co-curricular or extracurricular activities for which moneys from student-related activities (e.g., admissions, student fundraising events) were insufficient to meet the financial needs of the activity as a result of restrictions placed on the activity related to the COVD-19 pandemic.

This authority is effective during the following fiscal years: 2021, 2022, and 2023. The authority is set to be repealed effective July 1, 2023 (FY24). The full bill is available on the <u>Iowa Legislature</u> website.

## BOARD RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM GENERAL FUND TO STUDENT ACTIVITY FUND

WHEREAS, the superintendent, has recommended that funds of \$6,684.33 in the general fund be transferred to the student activity fund to fund cocurricular or extracurricular activities that fail to meet their financial needs as a result of COVID-19 restrictions in the school budget year beginning July 1, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board that funds of \$6,684.33 in the general fund be transferred to the student activity fund to fund cocurricular or extracurricular activities that fail to meet their financial needs as a result of COVID-19 restrictions in the school budget year beginning July 1, 2021.
