**SUBJECT: Presentation of Summer Academic Programs**

As you know, our district had three academic summer programs this year that were designed to prevent or reduce summer learning loss for elementary students. Two of the programs, Camp Emerson and Camp Frost, were for students from seven of our eight Title I Schools: Cleveland, Hayes, Garfield, Rosedale, Roosevelt, Cooper, and Johnson. Students who attended had just finished kindergarten through sixth grades this past school year. Since Title I funds were used to fund these two summer learning opportunities, only students from our Title I Schools were eligible to attend. The third program, Students Helping Students Literacy Program, was a summer literacy program available to any student who finished kindergarten and first grade at the end of this past school year who was in need of additional literacy intervention. This program is a collaborative partnership involving Madonna University, the Kirt Foundation and Livonia Public Schools.

I look forward to an opportunity to provide the Board of Education with an overview of these three summer academic programs during the Curriculum Committee portion of the Monday, September 11, agenda of the Committee of the Whole Meeting.
